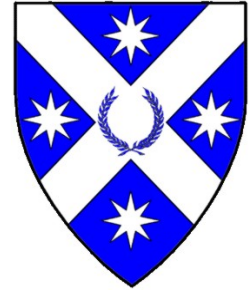

**Demo Location: Rudd Park on 3259 Irma Street**

Remember those Knights in Shining Armour as a youth, Well, Come out and see Full Armoured Combat in action and talk to us about what it entails to be there yourself. Come out and see a tournament in grand display. Cheer for your favourite fighter. Give him a favour of a ribbon to show your support.

Not into Full Armoured Knights and wish to try something Lighter?? How about being a Fencer, skilled in slight movements and quick footwork, and a thinner Blade but just as quick and deadly as the Full Armoured Combatants. Feel that Fighting is not your thing; well join us for the Lighter events such as Song and Dance. There will be displays throughout the day as well as a booth where you may learn to dance a few dances, in preparation for the Mask ball in the Evening. The Group also covers the Aspects of Belly dance, though I am uncertain as to whether any will be arriving this day. WE have a variety of Musicians within our Kingdom, join them around a bardic circle at events and sing along.

There is also, what we call Arts and Sciences, these are our Artisans, who assist in things throughout our Barony, covering pretty much anything that is crafted; Sewing, Embroidery, Leather making, Black work, Calligraphy, Garb Making. There are competitions to enter with such things if you have the competitive edge.

Still Searching, Well try your hand at Archery, though Not at this Demo. ( grins ) We do value the public after all. Come talk to those at the booth and find out more about that aspect of our group.

What about games? Do you like Chess? We have that, as well as a variety of other Period medieval games. Come talk to our games master at his booth.

What to do with the Children through all this, Well, We have Children's activities to keep them amused here as well as at events. There is also what we call Youth Combat for those who are not quite old enough o fight in the Full Armoured combat, but want to start early. Our group is very family oriented.

Feasting, We do that as well, but alas, not at this days event, but food merchants should be available (Still in the works with Permits and such )

Have Extra money to spend? We have Merchants at our events, selling things that are within the time period, their crafts and handiwork. See how skilled those within our Kingdom truly are. I believe we will have one Leather maker showing his wares, but this has yet to be confirmed.

Appledore is unique in that contenders for Champion compete in Archery, Armoured combat, Arts, Bardic, Rapier combat, and Sciences and accumulate points. Thus our Champion is a well-rounded representative of our shire and our society. *This year we challenge the good Ladies of Tir Righ to compete!*

**THE JOURNEY** is the theme for this year's Championship:

Archery	Take a stage to feed your caravan
Armoured	Repel the Brigands!
Arts	Create a trade good, pilgrim's badge, or other item you would collect or trade on your journey
Bardic	Tell a story or sing a song you've learned on your journey
Rapier	Defend your party against robbers!
Science	Create a device to measure time

"Periodness" and documentation will gain you more points.

Those wishing to compete for the Championship will be required to declare their intention to our current Champion Johannes Arbalaster Friday evening or Saturday morning. Anyone may compete in any or all of the categories, but only those who have declared for the Championship will accumulate Championship points.

**SCHOLARS OF ST THOMAS AQUINAS** is a companion persona challenge to the Tournament of the Golden Swan. More information can be found on the Scholars pages. Though we have had no candidates apply for the challenge this year, we do have two candidates who wish to make a "dry-run", we will be holding persona sessions and contests so these future candidates can gauge their performance and seek feedback from the Judges who will be present. Each category of the challenge is open to all who wish to enter.

**THE TAVERN** is open at all times, but on Saturday night we will be hosting a **Pot Luck Feast** - Bring a dish large enough to feed your party plus six more, and BYOBeverage of choice (*discretely wet site*). Bardic will take place during our repast. The shire will supply a roast Guinea Fowl.

# A LETTER FROM TIR RIGH ARTS & SCIENCES CHAMPION HL AELANA CORDOVERA

I would like to introduce myself to the populace, peers and nobility as the new Scholar of Tir Righ. My goals for the next year include the promotion of the Arts and Sciences by sponsoring Classes and Guilds, Displays and Demonstrations and Largesse Production, thus involving the general populace in learning and production of artifacts, research and interaction with peers and nobility.

My personal participation in the SCA has been in researching and producing artwork for demonstrations, classes and largesse. As Lions Gate Demo Coordinator for the last two years, I have come to appreciate how our clothing, armour and daily life articles fascinate school children and other folks both within and outside the SCA. This generates a desire for classes to learn about making things, again, within and outside the SCA. I recruit as I was recruited. My enthusiasm for making "stuff" grows as I see students taking such pride in the traditional craftsmanship of their own hands. This generates more research as I strive to answer student's questions about medieval methods.

This excitement for learning in Ithra classes first drew me into the SCA twenty three years ago, and gradually helped me overcome my initial shyness to become a teacher. I began to understand women's place in medieval society as I prepared for Golden Swan. Since my health has often prevented an active participation in events my sedentary production of crafts such as sewing, embroidery, painting helped maintain my sense of participation and belonging even when I couldn't attend events.

The Guilds were also an important part of learning and becoming more authentically involved in medieval processes-- Costumers, Embroiderers, Lace Makers and Scribal arts. I could challenge myself to move up by meeting the requirements of each Guild level and display my work to encourage others to do the same. When I discovered Medieval Book Binding I found I could combine my love of books and arts in one project. I

discovered carpentry, metalwork and leatherwork to cover my books. I even began a Bookbinders Guild and taught a One Year Program in Book Arts. I also plan a One Year Embroidery course for next year to encourage guild participation and largesse production. I have held many workshops to mass produce largesse for our royals-- hard and soft cover books, wax tablets, knitted bags and now embroidered bags. I am proud to show what a talented Principality we are as our royals hand out our workmanship far and wide.

So I will attend as many Principality events as I can manage, set up the Guild Hall and encourage classes, displays and contests. I will contact autocrats to see how I can encourage the arts and sciences at events and challenge the populace to get involved in producing our wonderful wares for display, gift giving and personal enhancement.

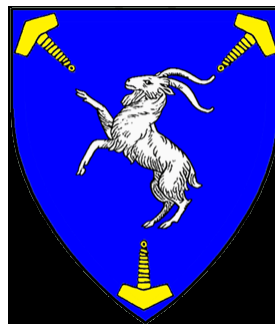

## **SUBMISSIONS INFORMATION**

This checklist is intended as an aid in the proper submission of event copy to "The Northern Sentinel". All copy for events at which official business is to take place must contain ALL of the information below for the enlightenment of the populace, legal, insurance, and tax purposes.

Required Items (must be included as a condition for publication)

- Date of the event (day and month). If the event will not be held during the Common Era year noted on the front cover of the newsletter, the announcement must also include the Common Era year.
- The time of the event: when the site opens and closes
- The name of the sponsoring group
- The location (name, street address, and town) of the site. The postal code should also be included if available.
- The name (both society and modern) and address of the autocrat.
- If there is a fee being charged for the event, the statement "Makes cheques payable to "<Group Name>", (or "<SCA, Inc. – Group Name>" for US groups) must be included
- If there is a fee being charged for the event, the #3.00 Non-Member Surcharge must be included. (See Policy Below).

### **Other Items**

- Official SCA Event Title (as your event will appear on the calendar)
- Modern Location (Use the town where the event site is located)

### **Non-Member Surcharge (NMS) Policy**

The NMS will apply to events which meet the requirements defined in Corpora section II.C., "...Society events for which a full announcement including date, time, and place has been published in advance in the

appropriate corporate publication;" and for which a fee or required donation to attend the event is charge. The NMS will not be collected if there is no fee or required donation to attend the event is charged. The NMS will not be collected for minors for All events must have an Event Information For (EIF) on file with the Kingdom (for Crown events) or Principality Calendar Deputy (<mailto:calendar@tirrigh.org>) for all other events.

**Please note that submitting your Event information will not effect whether or not NMS is being charged at the event. All events, whether NMS compliant or not, are welcome in the Northern Sentinel.**
