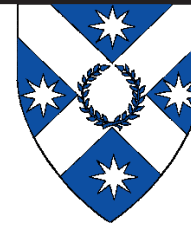

SITE RULES:

Fires: small fires are allowed in existing fire pits or in above-ground braziers. **NO LARGE FIRES.** You must have water nearby, and fires should not be left unattended. Tiki torches are allowed in open areas only (such as the eric field). No tiki torches in the wooded areas. All candles should be in enclosed candle lanterns - no open flame.

Site is extremely discreet. Please keep your beverages in period containers, and take ALL empties with you. **DO NOT** leave empties in trash.

Garbage: there is a garbage bin in the parking lot, but it is for garbage only. Take all recyclables with you when you leave.
