Once again the Shire of Krakenfjord will be hosting their Summer's End gathering in September. To that end we send out this invite to one and all, come if you dare and test yourself against Armoured warriors, draw your blades and cross them with cunningly skilled Rapiers. Quench your thirst for knowledge from the wise teachers that will travel from afar. Bring your words of wit and song for a bardic circle where many shall

enter but there can only be one survivor.

Come for fellowship, for challenge. for knowledge, for laughter and fun. Come and be part of our best event yet.



As usual, merchants are most welcome to come and ply their wares. There will be no extra merchant's fee, only the regular gate fee will apply. We will be trying something a little different this year. On Saturday we will be opening the merchants row to the local public to try and make this event a bit more worth while for the merchants. If you are planning on attending this event, please notify the Event Steward so space can be set aside for you.

There are restaurants within walking distance. We will have some onsite food available. Accommodations available next door to this site, the cost will be \$89 per night based on double occupancy...the cost might go down if we can book more than 7 rooms. A campsite is also located next door with power and water hook ups, the cost is \$20 per night on a first come first serve basis. We do have room onsite for some RVs without water and power.

### **Combat Challenges:**

There will be Heavy and Rapier competitions, but sadly no Archery.

### **A&S classes:** (Times have not be set yet)

#### *Needlework with Sine*

For the needlework class.....For it's best share of information 3 hours is best. An area to gather in where there wouldn't be too much interuption. A table would be very nice. Folks should bring their own chairs, & scissors. I provide a kit that includes everything else. The kit/class is \$5.00 and is very inclusive with a hoop, cloth, threads, needles, etc. and an extensive handout. Early Medieval Stitches. The history and practice of early embroidery stitches to embellish your medieval life. This is a very hands on class and you will have a project to complete at the end of the session.

#### *Beginning Rapier with Monsignour Draven*

This class will go over the history of rapier as it started here in the Kingdom of An Tir. I will also cover the techniques that provide a foundation for fighters looking to become involved in rapier and become authorized. The fundamentals of Italian Rapier will be demonstrated and discussed. A rapier and gloves are all that are required for this class. The length will be 1 hr.

For the A&S comopetition, our 2012 winner Lady Ismerelda has decided to SPICE things up, yes SPICES. The challenge is to create an entry involving SPICES for your own persona's home and time. Documentation will be required as usual. So do the research, grow some plants, do a display...let your imagination go wild.

**Bardic circle:** It is time for all good bards to dust off their thinking caps and sharpen the charcoal stick. Songs, poems and jokes, as long as it is true to the dream it counts. Got a drum, a pipe, or any other musical talent, bring it along and let the good times roll. There are also plans for an interesting version to the medieval insult competition, so look forward to this.
