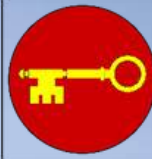
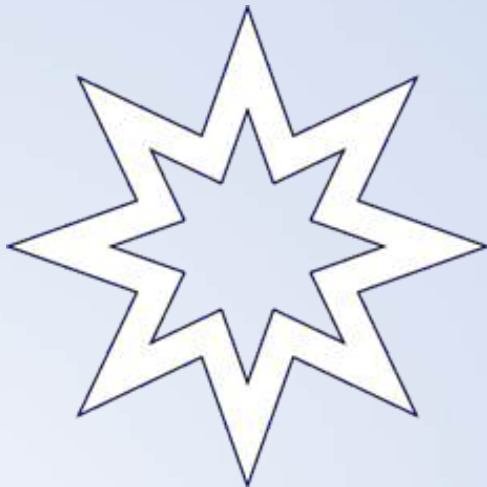

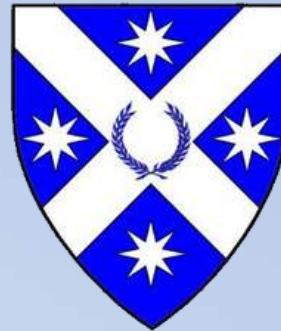

Scribal Thank You's for the Reign of Kheron and Athelina

Hello Tir Righ! Have you ever admired the beautiful art held up in court and wondered what went into the making of it? It's a huge undertaking to supply a reign with awards to give out, and scribes from all over the Principality come together to make it happen. We use a charter system which means that the preparation starts with submissions of words and artwork, then calligraphy. Everything is combined digitally then printed out on paper that is good for painting. Next printed charters are spread far and wide across the Principality and painters fill in the line work - each piece becomes unique - and then individual's names and award dates are filled in. Some awards are also given custom pieces, which means the art is a one-off that does not go through a printer and is designed for one recipient. A reign can often give 100+ awards, so that is a lot of art to hand out! This past reign, for Kheron and Athelina, there were over 50 people doing everything from putting together poetry to gluing on seals to painting up a storm. A massive thank you to all of them! 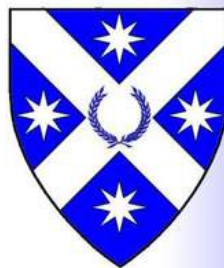

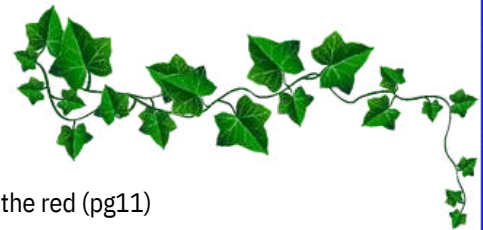
