

A Knights Tale

My journey to Knighthood in the SCA began when I was a small child during evening story time. Each night my father would read me a story before bed. Before long Dr. Seuss and Nursery Rhymes gave way to ancient myths and tales of adventure. The wanderings of clever Odysseus, the clash of prideful Achilles and mighty Hector, and the many adventures of the Knights of the Round Table filled imagination. I dreamed about being a hero like in those stories. In 1995 the SCA had a demo at a science fiction and fantasy convention that I attended. My decision was made; this was something I wanted to be a part of! Two years later, in the spring of 1997, now at the age of 18, I dug out the pamphlet I had received at the demo with eagerness. I remember being more than a bit nervous that evening, going my very first practice, and having any such feelings of reservation or awkwardness melted away by the warm welcome I received from the two individuals attending that practice: Mark of the White Hand, and Owain ap Einar. They were the first of many people I have met that have taught me, both by word and by deed, of the qualities required of a Peer in the SCA. I really enjoyed the first few years in the SCA. My involvement was limited to heavy combat, and Clinton War was the highlight of my year. In 2001 my participation faded away as I drifted into other activities that in retrospect were nowhere near as fulfilling or memorable. In 2007 I started thinking of my time with the SCA. It was a lot of fun, why did I stop doing that? I had no good answer. So, I started participating again, but now as a member of the Barony of Seagirt.

After a couple of years, I found myself doing more than just fighting on the tourney and war field. Only a year after my first practice back I was offered the opportunity to join the ranks of the Chivalry of the SCA. At the age of 46 I am glad that it is never too late to follow your dreams. Throughout my life it has been comforting to know that the dream, and my lifelong friends in the SCA, are waiting to welcome me back with open arms.

Thou art the drama, the main event, the walking soliloquy. But this month, be the wise lion. Mediate, don't dominate.


In love, practice what thou preacheth. Listen before roaring. A breakthrough cometh! Don't miss it by admiring thy own reflection.


